ICT Expectations

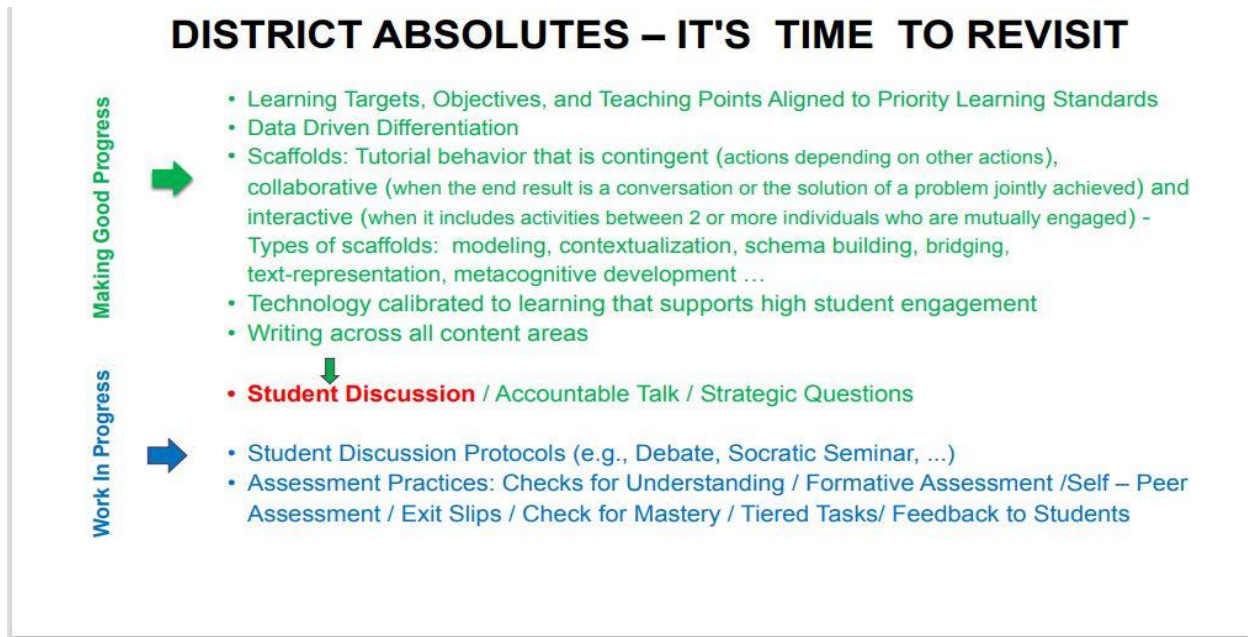
