Principal's Message

The GOOD NEWS continues! I am honored to be the PROUD Principal of the NEW Catherine \& Count Basie Magnet School for Multimedia and Performing Arts! We achieved our goal! CCB is no longer on the state list, we are a school in "Good Standing!" Let's continue to have high expectations for ALL scholars and provide a quality education in EVERY classroom.

Saturday Academy, session 2 was very successful, 85 scholars showed up for test prep. We have $\mathbf{2 0}$ instructional days before the NYS ELA Assessments and 26 instructional days before the NYS Math Assessments. This week's standards are:
ELA: 6R.6- Acquire and accurately use general academic and content-specific words and phrases; apply vocabulary knowledge when considering a word or phrase important to comprehension or expression.
ELA: 7R.1- Cite textual evidence to support an analysis of what the text says explicitly/implicitly and make logical inferences. (RI\&RL)
ELA: 8L.4- Determine or clarify the meaning of unknown and multiplemeaning words and phrases, choosing flexibly from a range of strategies.
Math: 6.NS. 1 - Interpret and compute quotients of fractions, and solve word problems involving division of fractions by fractions.
Math: 7.SP.3- Informally assess the degree of visual overlap of two quantitative data distributions
Math: 8.G3\& 4-Describe the effect of dilations, translations, rotations, and reflections on two-dimensional figures using coordinates. Lines of reflection are limited to both axes and lines of the form $y=k$ and $x=k$, where $k$ is a constant.

Thank you for sending attendance updates daily. Our YTD is $88.9 \%$. This is a school-wide effort for us to increase our YTD at least $2.2 \%$ this month. Attendance is EVERYONE'S business.
